Why Now: The "What-If" Team had the idea for these things in 2019 with the priority being the new Children's Wing. This updated wing has allowed us to minister to new families through VBS and is currently allowing us the opportunity to meet together in small groups. The need to continue in renovations is very important and will see us into the future. The time is NOW to continue in the process of getting things up to simply the way they should be in regards to stewardship and usability. One example is the sheer number of leaks in the roof of the worship center. Any time it rains, particularly hard rain, we have an incredible amount of roof leaks that occur. Another example is the lack of safe and updated space we have for our student ministry. We must invest in the future of our church by taking care of these areas. Simply stated, it is time to look at our



facility head-on and make the needed improvements and renovations in order to allow us to minister to families and provide an adequate space for them to grow in Christ. We must demonstrate UNITY in our efforts like never before. A NEW DAY capital campaign will be the conduit that we can all financially give to in order to make these things happen.

Next Steps: In February of 2020, the church approved the work for the Capital Campaign to begin. The Capital Campaign Team was organized and began working by August of 2020 and is now ready to officially begin the campaign for the entire church. Crossroads will officially begin its 3-year capital campaign on January 1, 2021. We will have a special giving day on December 6, 2020 called "First Fruits Day" and celebrate a one-time offering that will Kick-Start the campaign! You will learn more in the days ahead. The hopes are that the church will have \$750,000 cash in hand by, on or before, the end of the 3 year campaign. No decisions have been made as to how fundraising would continue after the campaign. The church will take appropriate actions at that time as to how to fundraise the remaining 1,250,000. The hope in this campaign is not to eliminate a loan, but to raise as much money possible and to minimize the amount borrowed.

As we move forward you will be given more information and opportunities to receive help planning for your estimates and commitments. Please begin now praying about how God will have you support this endeavor.


goals during the capital campaign. Please be in prayer about how God can use you and your family to play a huge role in the future of Crossroads Community Church.


