Dinner will be served at 5:30 and Bible Study at 6:30pm.

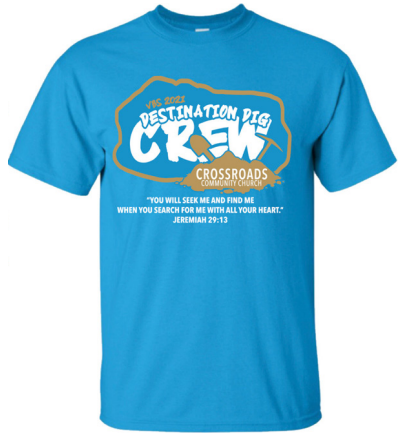
Sunday morning:

We will have LifeGroups at 10:00am in between the services!

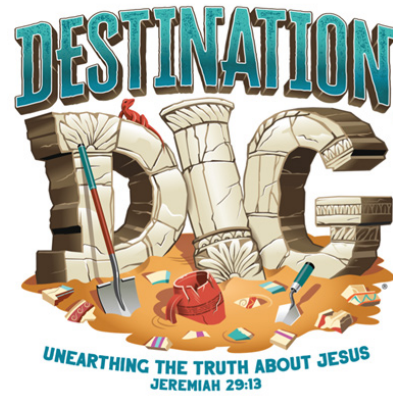

UPDATE ON MRS. JANE

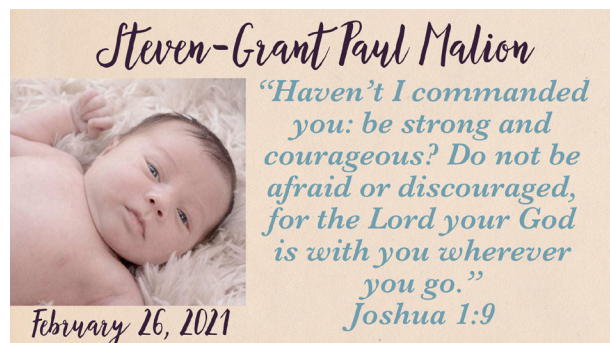
