## AN INTERVIEW WITH JANE

As many of you know, our sweet Jane Barrett has been diagnosed with Breast Cancer. We wanted to take a few minutes to sit down with her and talk about what God is doing in the midst of her storm.

June 1st I found a lump and just three days later on June 4th I found out I had breast cancer, In an unbelievably quick time frame I have been able to see an Oncologist, Cardiologist, Surgeons, etc. The Lord has orchestrated every single step of appointments and testing. Thankfully, the cancer has not metastasized anywhere in the body-it is self contained. The moment I heard the words "It's Cancer", I have known that God is walking with us. I have a beautiful peace that only comes from The Lord. I know that I am in His hands and while he did not give me cancer, He is walking right beside me as we go through this. God does not make mistakes and I know that He is going to use this to grow His kingdom. I know that He will heal me one way or another and I am trusting in Him and His leadership through this. No matter what He has for me, I am thankful to walk with Him through this. I don't think God is through with me yet-I believe He wants to use this as another tool for me to share the gospel with people locally and at MD Anderson. My only goal through this is to honor and glorify Him and to spread His word. Everytime we get a test result or a delay in anything the first thing I say is "Thank you God"! I want the first thing on my lips to be praise for his provision over all of this.

As of the time of this writing, my surgery is scheduled for July 27th. I will have a double mastectomy on that day-less than two months after finding a lump-Only God can orchestrate that incredible timing in the midst of a worldwide pandemic.

MD Anderson has been such a blessing and I know The Lord has us there for specific reasoning. Kanny and I are firmly convinced that MD Anderson is the place God wants us to be. We have met with several doctors and nurses there and we know that the team there is the team that God has for me. We have not had a single bad experience with any of them. Several doctors have said they were praying for me and I have a holy peace about the care I will receive there.

How can we specifically pray for you and your family right now? Pray that I stay healthy and safe. I am having to take major precautions to be safe and stay well over the next month. Pray specifically that I can have only one surgery-there is a lead to my pacemaker that has to be moved and we are praying that it can be done with the mastectomy. Pray for traveling mercies as we travel back at the end of the month. Specifically pray for my surgeon and the team that I will be under their care.

We love our church family and we are counting on your prayers and support during this time.
